| <input type="checkbox"/> Look for dents, rust, or other damage. | <input type="checkbox"/> Drive over 55 MPH to test acceleration, gear shifts, and steering. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Check the windshield for cracks or chips | <input type="checkbox"/> Practice parking. Be sure you are comfortable |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Open and close every door. | <input type="checkbox"/> Check the car goes in reverse |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Check for uneven wear on the tire tread | <input type="checkbox"/> Get a technology tour from the seller (automatic cruise control, Bluetooth radio, etc.). |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Start car, idle, and listen for rattles, clicks, or whines from the engine. | <input type="checkbox"/> Confirm what type of gas or higher octane fuel the car takes. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Test the turn signals, brake lights, radio, heater, A/C, windshield wipers, warning lights, and other gauges. | <input type="checkbox"/> Ask the seller for a vehicle history report to check for accidents. (ex: CarFax) |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Drive in stop-and-go traffic to check the brakes. | <input type="checkbox"/> Ask if anything broken can be fixed. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> Go slowly over potholes and rough roads to see how it handles and steers. | <input type="checkbox"/> Find out if it comes with an extended warranty! |
